Islam arrived in South and Southeast Asia primarily via conquest and trade. The arrival of Islam brought political, social, and cultural changes to the people of these two regions. Also during this period, new technological advances allowed trade to expand on the Indian Ocean. The development of the Indian Ocean trade network facilitated the spread of culture and influenced the rise of new political states throughout the Indian Ocean basin.</p>
