

AP WORLD HISTORY EXAM STUDY SESSIONS

Dear APWH Students,

The Advanced Placement World History exam will be given on Thursday, May 13th. To prepare for this challenging test, Mr. Millhouse and Ms. Gray are offering study sessions to all former and present AP World History students. *While these sessions are optional, it is expected that ANY student who signs up for the exam attend as many as possible. Not attending the sessions will result in a lower test score!*

Sessions will be lecture and participatory with opportunity to answer questions and review valuable material. Bring pen and paper for notes to each session. Sessions will be held in Ms Gray's room (2600) and Mr. Millhouse's room (2620). There will be two sessions for each topic listed below. The morning session will be from 7:35 -8:35, and the afternoon session will be from 4:15-5:15. *We will start promptly, so arrive on time!*

Study materials, which will supplement but not replace the study sessions or practice test, are available from either teacher. Both teachers have flashcards, practice tests, and study books, etc. Students who are not currently in the class, but need a textbook may see Mr. Bradley. The practice test will be held from 9-12 on Saturday, May 1st. It is critical that students attend and take the session seriously. Understanding the exam process is very helpful. Students will take an actual released exam, write practice essays, and receive information on how the exam is scored.
